The Antique Blue Topper is an in the hoop appliquéd project designed and digitized by Donna exclusively for Snip and Stitch Sewing Centre. Pick your favourite border fabric and coordinating fabrics to make your own Antique Topper. Learn all about appliquéd fabric preparation, stabilizing, multi-hooping and simple finishing techniques. This class is suitable for all brands of embroidery machines with a minimum hoop size of 200 X 200 mm. Suitable for beginners. All embroidery designs, appliquéd patterns and instructions are included in the class fee.

<p>Combo Sewing/Embroidery Machine or Sewing Machine and Stand Alone Embroidery Machine with standard presser foot and usual embroidery supplies including</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">200 X 200 mm or larger HoopPower CordFoot control (for sewing the top)USB stick. Please make sure your USB stick works in your machine! With rapidly changing technology it is impossible for me to predict what size or Brand of USB stick will work in various machines. If your machine did come with a USB stick, bring that one.Embroidery foot	

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0.5 medium blue for appliquéd background	
0.2 m white print fabric for pieced inner border and applique	
0.2 m medium-dark blue for pieced inner border and applique	
1.0 m blue print for outer border	
0.3 m tone on tone dark navy blue for binding and applique	
0.8 m fabric for backing	
36 X 36 in square batting	
Fabric for appliqués <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 0.3 m tan01 for large corner flowers and pieced inner border • 0.2 m or scraps tan 02 for large leaves • 0.2 m or scraps white print 02 for small leaves and for corner flower base • 0.2 m or scraps tone on tone tan and corner flower base and for stems • 0.2 or scraps dark navy print for center flower and berries. 	
1.0 m Wonder Under fusible web if you will be cutting your appliquéd pieces with a digital cutter.	
Quilters Select Appli-Stick Printer Sheets or OEsd Appliquéd Fuse and Fix Sheets These help you hand cut your appliquéd shapes more accurately than tracing because I can run them through a printer for you	
OEsd Ultra Clean and Tear Stabilizer Or Inspira Tear Away	
Machine Embroidery thread to coordinate with appliquéd fabrics—50 wt Mettler cotton used on sample.	
Machine embroidery bobbin thread or pre-wounds	
Janome Red Tip or 90/14 Machine embroidery needles	
Mary Ellen's Best Press (unscented for class use please).	
All purpose thread to match	

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6 X 24 ruler, mat and rotary cutter.	
Fabric pen or pencil	
Seam ripper	
Straight pins	
Sharp scissors for pre-cutting appliquéd shapes.	
Mini Iron and Press Surface	

PRE-CLASS PREPARATION

Use Mary Ellen's Best Press to starch all your fabrics.

PREP-CLASS

Do not bring your embroidery machine or embroidery supplies to this class.

Bring your starched and pressed appliquéd fabrics. If you are hand cutting your appliquéd shapes also bring your printable fusible web sheets, small sharp scissors, pencil, rotary cutter, mat and ruler. Once I have printed your appliquéd patterns on your fusible web sheets you can begin cutting out the appliquéd shapes.

If you are using a digital cutter to cut your appliquéd shapes bring your starched and pressed appliquéd fabrics and WonderUnder Fusible Web. Also bring a rotary cutter, mat and ruler. You will be measuring and fusing the WonderUnder to the wrong side of your fabrics for cutting at home.
